- Track and verify inventory records electronically and physically in stock to ensure accuracy of supply count.
- Order inventory from manufacturer to meet minimum stock level requirements.
- Determine proper storage methods, identification, and stock location based on turnover and physical capabilities of facility.
- Report any damaged stock or equipment, ensure goods are packed, labeled, and stored properly.
- Maintain a positive, empathetic, and professional attitude towards customer and sales teams.
- Respond promptly to customer service team and sales team inquiries.
